# The 1<sup>st</sup> International Workshop on Internet Survey

**Daejeon, S. Korea, September 9-10, 2009**

Internet and IT-based survey is a growing trend for every statistic nowadays. Thus, there are considerable needs of diversified and in-depth researches on the quality gap of statistics between traditional interview survey and Internet survey. The workshop will cover major issues, alternatives of Internet survey, actual Internet survey, and case studies of several countries relevant to web-based data collection. It aims to observe through this survey that this is an effective way of improving convenience, efficiency and accuracy through the use of latest Internet survey methodologies.

We kindly invite you to submit a paper to be presented at this workshop. Focus will be on the following topics:

**Session 1: Major issues of Internet Survey:** Issues in volunteers and non-volunteers, estimation of Internet survey volunteers samples, estimation of survey errors and methodologies of reducing survey errors, impacts of Internet survey on the quality of statistics, etc.

**Session 2: E-Census** Necessities and benefits of Internet survey for Population Census due to changes in survey environment, methodologies relevant to cost, sampling and multi-mode, effects of changes in survey methodologies, e-Census methodologies of Singapore, e-enumeration using the Internet banking system and electronic tax board environment in Estonia, etc.

**Session 3: Applications of Internet Survey** Case studies on applications of Internet survey in Social Science, setting up a panel for Internet survey, the development of an Internet channel for data collections, Propensity Score Adjustment of Internet survey, applications of IT to survey researches, etc.

**Session 4: Case Studies: Applications of Internet survey** Case studies on applications of Internet survey of Korea, Canada, Switzerland, Netherlands, etc.

**Session 5: Round Table (Future Prospect of Internet Survey):** Plan to broaden Internet survey and its future prospect-Discussion on agendas for the next workshop
